A feasibility study (FS) is being conducted at Acid Areas 2 & 3 at the former Plum Brook Ordnance Works by the United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE). As required by the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA), USACE is requesting the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, as lead regulator, to provide preliminary chemical and location-specific Applicable or Relevant and Appropriate Requirements (ARARs) for USACE review and evaluation in the FS. At this time there is no need to provide action-specific ARARs since these will be developed in the FS after an alternative passes the initial screening step in the FS process.
