Dear Mr. Bohne:

This is in response to your December 29, 2006, letter to Lieutenant General Carl Strock, concerning issues related to the assignment of project management responsibilities at Plum Brook Ordnance Works (PBOW).

Your letter to Brigadier General Bruce A. Berwick, Commander, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Great Lakes and Ohio River, on the same date and concerning the same subject issues has been answered by BG Berwick directly. The recent changes at a national level to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of the Formerly Used Defense Sites (FUDS) Program mean that Huntington District will no longer be a FUDS Program and Project Management District. The Huntington District will, however, retain project management responsibilities for on-going work at PBOW and they will continue to be supported by Nashville District.

Your working relationship with both Districts should not be affected by our reorganization revisions. You will be kept informed of our decision-making process. Should you have additional concerns related to cleanup of PBOW, please do not hesitate to contact your working partners in the Huntington and Nashville Districts.
