Dear Ms. Flatt:


Per your request, we are sending you drawings showing facilities which were operational during the time period that the Plum Brook Ordnance Works manufactured munitions on lands that NASA currently occupies. We are also sending you a portion of a recent Environmental Compliance Audit Report which relates to the problem areas.

The enclosed copies of correspondence are also significant because they relate to one of the red water areas within Parcel 59 at the western part of the station which has been exceeded. The Ohio Army National Guard is currently interested in ownership of this land.

We suggest that you contact Mr. Mark Gibson, State of Ohio Adjutant General's Department, to determine current interest and proposed commitments to Parcel 59. As I mentioned in our telecon, there are voluminous records pertaining to the Plum Brook Ordnance Works in our record files.
