The RAB Meeting was conducted on September 15, 2005 at Firelands College. The following is a summary of the discussions, presentations and Action Items.

Reservoir No. 2 Burn Grounds Remedial Investigation Update – Jacobs Engineering

Al Hardesty (Jacobs Engineering) provided an update of the Reservoir No. 2 Burn Grounds investigation . Mr. Hardesty reviewed the location of the area, the burn layer boundary, and the distribution of contaminants. Mr. Hardesty also reviewed the locations of the additional soil samples collected in April 2005 and presented the analytical results of the sampling activities. The presentation is included as part of the minutes.

There are several wells in service for the pump and treat system at the reactor. A question was asked about the impact of the wells operating at the NASA Reactor on the direction of flow through the Reservoir No. 2 Burn Grounds. An Action Item was called for.

ACTION ITEM – Determine if the pumps at the reactor facility are still operational, and if so, inquire about the schedule for terminating operation.

Geology and Soils Tutorial – Bennett & Williams

Julie Weatherington-Rice (Bennett & Williams), the RAB TAPP contractor provided review of the TAPP objectives and an overview of the transport of water through geologic fractures.
