## **PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD NOTICE**

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Huntington District will be conducting a public meeting to present the Proposed Plan for Reservoir 2 Burning Grounds – Former Plum Brook Ordnance Works, Sandusky, Ohio.

The public meeting is scheduled for Tuesday August 14, 2012 at 7:00 p.m. in the Bettcher Room located on the second floor in the Cedar Point Center on the campus of BGSU Firelands. BGSU Firelands is located at One University Drive, Huron, Ohio.

The former Plum Brook Ordnance Works (PBOW) manufactured explosives during World War II. The USACE has completed a Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study in the Reservoir No. 2 Burning Grounds to identify contamination resulting from activities associated with the manufacture of explosives. The Proposed Plan identifies alternatives evaluated to remediate the contaminated soil.

The proposed alternative to remediate the soil contamination is Alternative 4 and includes excavation, alkaline hydrolysis (AH), chemical stabilization, off-site disposal and on-site placement.
