Review comments from Dave Bishop, USACE, LRN, Nashville District, received June 25, 2009.

Comment 1: The plan identifies Tom Siard as having a medical exam in 2005. I recommend he be scheduled for an exam or that the plan clearly identify why he is an exception.

Response 1: Tom Siard will be removed from the Plan since he does not go in the field.

Comment 2: The Plan identifies David Kessler as the only individual with 1st Aid/CPR training. Suggest they consider one other employee for this training.

Response 2: Shaw employees Mike Gunderson and Eric Weaver, both with current First Aid and CPR training, will be added to the Plan.

Comment 3: The Plan identifies training but does not identify the individual(s) that are Competent with soil classification and excavation safety. Suggest they clearly identify the individual(s) competent in excavation safety.

Response 3: The Plan will be revised to identify Mike Gunderson as competent with soil classification and excavation safety.

Comment 4: The AHA located at Table 5-1 is very thorough. The only thing they might add that I caught would be the prohibition of operating a motor vehicle while using a handheld cell phone.

Response 4: Agreed. Table 5-1 will be revised to reflect that operating a motor vehicle while using a handheld phone is prohibited by Shaw Policy HS800.

Comment 5: The plan makes reference to use of the 3394 to document accidents but I didn't notice where the USACE representative will be notified in a timely manner. That may be in a different document but I question the communication loop.

Response 5: The text will be revised to indicate that the USACE will be notified by either by the on-site USACE representative or by the Shaw project manager.

Review comments from Jim Beaujon, USACE, LRN, Nashville District, received June 19, 2009.

Comment 1: On the Emergency Contacts sheet David Kessler is listed as “Shaw Site Supervisor.” Is that still valid?

Response 1: No, the Emergency Contacts will be revised to show that Mike Gunderson will be the Shaw Site Supervisor.
