The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Division of Emergency and Remedial Response (DERR), has reviewed the submittal titled "Recommendation for On-Site Disposal of Investigation-Derived Waste Generated from Groundwater Investigation at the Former Plum Brook Ordnance Works Sandusky, Ohio." This document was submitted to the Ohio EPA by the International Technology Corporation for review and comments. Ohio EPA, DERR is providing the following comments:

1. The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Division of Emergency and Remedial Response (DERR), has reviewed the analytical data and found the materials to be minimally contaminated.
2. The proposed manner of disposal is not inconsistent with previously approved disposal techniques for the Plum Brook Ordnance site.
3. The Department of the Army, Corps of Engineers, may proceed with the proposed plan for disposal of Investigation-Derived Waste.
