1. Reference memorandum, CEHND-PM-OT, 11 April 1991, subject:
Defense Environmental Restoration Program - Formerly Used Defense
Sites (DERP-FUDS); Project No. G03WV006500; Right-of-Entry for
Ordnance Feasibility Study (FS) at the Former West Virginia
Maneuver Area, Davis, WV.
2. The referenced memorandum informed you that a contract to
perform a feasibility study at the subject site had been awarded.
During the contractor's site visit and as a result of interviews
with Department of Agriculture (DOA) Forest Service personnel,
the contractor has determined that the site with the most
potential for ordnance contamination is not covered by the
subject INPR. The INPR only covered property owned and operated
by DOA as the Dolly Sods Wilderness and Scenic Area. The site
with the most potential for ordnance contamination is Blackbird
Knob which is located about 2 miles west of Red Creek Campground
and on private property. Blackbird Knob was used as a target for
mortar and artillery fire.
3. Request you revise the INPR to include the property
encompassing Blackbird Knob and determine DERP-FUDS eligibility.
Request the revised INPR be provided to us by 25 June 1991 so
that the on-going contract can be modified to cover the new
property with minimum cost impacts.
