

Enclosed is a copy of the project map for explosive ordinance removal within Dolly Sods Wilderness with known heritage resource site locations indicated. You will note that five logging era sites have been documented to date. As we discussed yesterday, I anticipate that numerous others exist within the project area, particularly adjacent to abandoned railroad grades. Please recall that this map is not to be made part of the public record, as such documentation is exempt from the Freedom of Information Act. 


