

Dolly Sods Unexploded Munitions Records Available to Public

HUNTINGTON — The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers announced administrative record files on the removal of unexploded munitions at Dolly Sods are available for public review and commentary.

The administrative record file includes documents that form the

basis for the selection of the removal action at the site.

Documents in the file may include, but are not limited to: preliminary assessments, site reports, remedial investigations and feasibility studies, work plans and other technical reports. Documents will be added to the records as site work continues.

The public is provided with a 30-day comment period on the administrative record file beginning July 31.
