RE: Dolly Sods Wilderness Legal Advertising and Environmental Assessment Placement

Attached are a draft Notice of Availability and a draft letter to accompany the Draft Environmental Assessments which will be sent to libraries and WVU Extension offices.

Regarding the Notice of Availability, do we need to include street addresses for the libraries and Extension offices? (I guess Nancy has already asked you about this.)

Nancy Vyas mentioned to you that it appears easiest and fastest to place the necessary legal advertisements through the West Virginia Press Association. They will direct the proper ad to the correct newspaper, collect the necessary certificates of publication, and bill you for the advertising. The only exception is the Cumberland, Maryland paper, which is not a member of the Association. They will bill the Corps directly.


We understand that the ads are to appear in each newspaper weekly over four weeks. The West Virginia daily newspapers do not accept legal notices for publication on Sunday, so we are proposing to begin publication in the dailies on Monday, July 10. We have listed the target papers and the publication dates below the draft Notice for your information and approval.

After surveying each of the papers about their rates for running the legal notices according to our word count and estimated length, we estimate that all notices should not cost more than \$500.

Please contact either Nancy or me as soon as possible concerning the correctness of the Notice of Availability. We should get this in the hands of the Press Association today not later than tomorrow (July 6, 1995) if we are to make publication on Monday, July 9. We also need a requisition number or other such binder for invoicing purposes, especially in the case of the Cumberland paper.

Va. Ordnance remaining from World War II artillery training exercises will be removed from trails and campsites.
