Dear Mr. Cline:

This letter documents authorization for the Department of the Army, Corps of Engineers, and its contractor Metcalf & Eddy, and sub-contractor UXB International, to conduct an Ordnance Study in the Dolly Sods Wilderness Area this summer, DERP-FUDS Project No. G03WV006500. The study will be conducted in accordance with the 3/26/91 Scope of Work and the Work Plan prepared for this project. Field work will be completed by October 11, 1991.

In all work activities, the Corps and its contractors will make every reasonable effort to minimize damage to the wilderness resources and to minimize evidence of human activity within the wilderness. They will keep the Forest Service apprised of all activities that will affect any known populations of Threatened, Endangered, or Sensitive Species and will work with the Forest Service to minimize any adverse effects to these species. They will also be responsible for keeping the Forest visitors out of the danger area prior to detonating a charge.

UXB will coordinate with the District Ranger or other Forest Service Personnel at the Potomac Ranger Station prior to all demolition operations, and will keep them informed of project progress.
